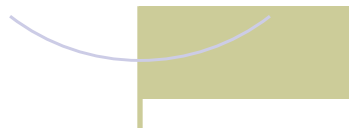

New State Government and MVED Hours

Due to Governor Huntsman's Executive Order, most State offices will be closed on Fridays. As of August 4, 2008 MVED will have office working hours of 7:00 AM until 6:00 PM Monday thru Thursday.

Temporary Permit Fee Increase

The fee to purchase a book of temporary permits will be raised .50 cents per permit as of August 4, 2008. As of that date, the fee for a book of 25 permits will be \$200.25. If you are licensed as a dealership please see the enclosed revised Application for Motor Vehicle Temporary Permits TC-756.

The registration fees on certain types of vehicles increased in January 2008. Our permit fees to clear permits were not changed at that time due to our yearly permit audits. The permit fees to clear temporary permits for non residents or voids/rollbacks will change on August 4, 2008. If you are licensed as a dealership please see the enclosed fee sheet listing the new amounts.

Notary on MVED Applications

As of July 1, 2008, it will no longer be necessary to notarize the applications for a business, plate/decals, salesperson or salvage buyer. There are two forms that will still require a notary, the TC-450 Bond Of Motor Vehicle Dealer, Crusher or Body Shop and the TC-465 Waiver. The new applications are available online.
